Privacy Policy

This document is published in accordance with the provisions of Rule 3 (1) of the Information Technology (Intermediaries Guidelines) Rules, 2011, which requires publishing the rules and regulations, Privacy Policy and Terms of Service for the access or usage of https://www.mysorepridemembers.com/ ("Website") and MYSORE PRIDE MEMBERS ("App"). The Website and App are owned and operated by PRIDETECH SOLUTIONS with its place of business at Office: 3381, 20th E Main, Vijayanagar 2nd Stage, Mysore, Karnataka 570017, INDIA., (hereinafter referred to as "We", "Us" or "Our") This Privacy Policy covers the use of this Website and the App, including providing You the information of our policies regarding the collection, use and disclosure of Personal Information when You use our Service. We are concerned about the privacy of the users (hereinafter referred to as "You", "Your" or "User") of Website and App and have provided this privacy policy statement (the "Privacy Policy") to familiarize You with the manner in which we collect, use and disclose Your information. We will not use or share Your information with anyone except as described in this Privacy Policy. We use Your Personal Information for providing and improving the Service/s offered by our partners and us. By using the Service, You agree to the collection and use of information in accordance with this policy. Unless otherwise defined in this Privacy Policy, terms used in this Privacy Policy have the same meanings as in our Terms and Conditions.

1. What information do we collect? We collect information from You when You register on the Website/App, our social media assets like Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, Linked-in or other digital assets place an order, respond to a survey or communication such as e-mail, or participate in another Website/App feature.
